1. Will the application be considered not as strong if only one person from the organization applies?

3. Will the trainings take an entire day?

Yes, the trainings will begin at 8:00 a.m. and go through the entire day, with a break for lunch. We should dismiss by 4:30 p.m., but this may be dependent on discussion and engagement throughout the day.

4. Does this include sitting for the certification exam?

Upon completion of the final tollgate, submission of an entire project with all project deliverables, and upon MHA and vendor review, certifications will be rewarded.

5. Does the project include 46 organizations or 46 people? Forty-six people. Example: If every organization has a team of two, the total would be 23 organizations.

6. Do you see another program being offered at another time for those that are on the wait list?

This project currently is funded through the HIIN. Dependent on funding there may be the potential of a future project.

7. If my organization preselects the two applicants and only submits two applications, will this ensure their selection?

If your organization is selected, the two applicants will be selected together for your team of two. If there is a concern regarding one of the applicants, a phone interview may be arranged to further clarify and discuss the application along with responses. It will not, however, ensure selection for the project if we receive more than 46 applications.

8. Should we attach a CV with the application?
